2006 ZONE-O-RAMA

On December 4, 2004, Kerry Barnes, Lynn Hargus and Mary Parrott, traveled to Tunica, Mississippi to represent our state and its two clubs at a meeting of the Zone 6 Coordinating Committee; they were joined by representatives from the Arkansas, the Mississippi and the Tennessee Paint Horse Clubs. Major discussion centered around the location, and a date, for a Zone-O-Rama to be held in 2006, with the Paul M. Battle Arena in Tunica and the Ike Hamilton Expo Center in West Monroe being the two facilities considered to host the show. After a review of the information on the Tunica facility, Mary and Lynn presented to the representatives a proposal from the IKE Hamilton Expo Center along with a sample budget, show entry numbers, etc., After discussion of dates (which included LPHC allowing the Zone-O-Rama to be held on its February date in 2006) and reviewing all other materials, the representatives agreed that since each club would be expected to bear the expenses, each club in the Zone would be represented on the Coordinating Committee and would have a vote. When the votes on the location/date of the 2006 Zone-O-Rama were tallied, the IKE was chosen as the location of the show.
